POLICE REPORT

Wellfleet Police Department – 2017

The following is a summary the activities and calls of the Wellfleet Police Department. Hopefully you will find this of some value.

A quick overview of what is contained within this report.

"A Year In Review" highlights some of the events that happened in Wellfleet over the past year. Most of the photos were placed on our Facebook page as they occurred.

"Personnel Roster" identifies the employees of the department in 2017.

"Mission Statement" & "Department Values" are identified.

"Use of Force Summary" All use of force are documented throughout the year and reviewed by the command staff. At the end of the year, the Lieutenant conducts an analysis of all the reports and makes a written report to the Chief.

"Vehicle Pursuit" All vehicle pursuits are documented throughout the year and reviewed by the command staff. At the end of the year, the Lieutenant conducts an analysis of all the reports and makes a written report to the Chief.

"Motor Vehicle Crash Location" identifies where a crash had occurred. These crashes may have happened at an intersection or a driveway or parking lot of the identified street. No fatalities occurred over the past year.

"Locations of Motor Vehicle Offenses" shows where the motor vehicle stops occurred. In 2017 there was 1,819 motor vehicle stops. As you would expect a majority of those took place on Rt. 6.

"Motor Vehicle Offenses" identify the infractions for the motor vehicle stop.

"Federal IBR Crime Report" is what is collected by the federal government. Most state laws don't blend well with other states so the Federal Government collects the information under a wide umbrella.

"Arrest Status Report" identifies all the arrest (168 with 21 intoxicated individuals) that was made for the year and what they were charged with. These arrests include those taken into physical custody and those who were summons (given a date to appear in court at some future time). No names or identifiable information is being provided or details of the event.

"Monthly Report" is a report that is created for the Board of Selectmen highlighting the different events happening within the Wellfleet Police Department. As part of the report a numerical breakdown of costs, call for service etc. is provided.

Wellfleet Police Department – A Year In Review – 2017

January






Memorial Day Service – due to weather, the annual service was held inside the Congregationall Church for the 2nd year.



Pan Mass Challenge



9-11 Remembrance:



Wellfleet authorized the WPD Pink Patch for the month of October for cancer awareness.






Cookies for a Cop; local cape moms have made their way across the cape delivering cookies to the police to show their appreciation. This is part of a national campaign.



| Officer Holway and Sergeant Turner responded to a residence for a reported domestic assault between boyfriend and girlfriend. When Sergeant Turner arrived on scene the male subject ran in the house and frantically attempted to pull down shades. A few moments later the male subject ran out the front door screaming and jumped into the driver's seat of his vehicle. The male subject started the vehicle and began revving the engine. Fearing that the male subject would injure or cause serious bodily harm if he left Sergeant Turner drew his taser and deployed the taser into his left shoulder. The subject was not affected by the taser and was again trying to flee the area. Sergeant Turner deployed his Taser a second time in an attempt to subdue the male subject. Once other officers arrived on location the male subject was taken into custody and transported to Cape Cod Hospital for evaluation. | |
