# Wellfleet Police Department – 2018

The following is a summary the activities and calls of the Wellfleet Police Department. Hopefully you will find this of some value.

A quick overview of what is contained within this report.

"A Year In Review" highlights some of the events that happened in Wellfleet over the past year. Most of the photos were placed on our Facebook page as they occurred.

"Personnel Roster" identifies the employees of the department in 2018.

"Mission Statement" & "Department Values" are identified.

"Use of Force Summary" All use of force are documented throughout the year and reviewed by the command staff. At the end of the year, the Lieutenant conducts an analysis of all the reports and makes a written report to the Chief.

"Vehicle Pursuit" All vehicle pursuits are documented throughout the year and reviewed by the command staff. At the end of the year, the Lieutenant conducts an analysis of all the reports and makes a written report to the Chief.

"Motor Vehicle Crash Location" identifies where a crash had occurred. These crashes may have happened at an intersection or a driveway or parking lot of the identified street. No fatalities occurred over the past year.

"Locations of Motor Vehicle Offenses" shows where the motor vehicle stops occurred. In 2018 there was 1,981 motor vehicle stops. As you would expect a majority of those took place on Rt. 6.

"Motor Vehicle Offenses" identify the infractions for the motor vehicle stop.

"Federal IBR Crime Report" is what is collected by the federal government. Most state laws don't blend well with other states so the Federal Government collects the information under a wide umbrella.

"Arrest Status Report" identifies all the arrest (163 with 23 intoxicated individuals) that was made for the year and what they were charged with. These arrests include those taken into physical custody and those who were summons (given a date to appear in court at some future time). No names or identifiable information is being provided or details of the event.

"Monthly Report" is a report that is created for the Board of Selectmen highlighting the different events happening within the Wellfleet Police Department. As part of the report a numerical breakdown of costs, call for service etc. is provided.

#### January



Wellfleet Police Officer Charles D. Williams, 34 years of age died on 7/19/1931 when struck by a delivery truck while directing traffic on Main Street, Wellfleet.








Throughout the year we are kept busy with different motor vehicle crashes. We ask all operators to be attentive to driving, no texting, no operating under the influence, or other distractions.





Large branches from an iconic tree on Main Street came down in the early am wind storm. The damaged and aged tree had to be removed at a later date.





# Wellfleet Police Department USE OF FORCE SUMMARY 2018

Policy #025 Policy #027

The following is a summary report for Use of Force incidents that occurred in 2018. Pursuant to Policy #025 & #027, the Lieutenant shall conduct an annual analysis of all use of force reports and submit a written report to the Chief.

Sergeant Brazile March 30, 2018 Baker Ave

Reviewed on April 3, 2018 and found to be within Guidelines.

### Synopsis:

Officer responded to the residence to assist Wellfleet Fire Department on a doctor ordered transport. The female party needed to be transported to Cape Cod Hospital and her son was interfering with medical staff. The male party blocked the bed so the fire department could not treat and after refusing to move Sgt Brazile placed the subject in an escort position and moved him toward the door. Paramedics were then able to treat and there were no further issues.

Sergeant Paul Clark April 11, 2018 Duck Pond Road

### Synopsis:

Officers responded to the residence to investigate a mental health issue going on with the owner's son. The male party in question was walking in circles not making sense and his family was concerned for his safety. Officers determined that subject needed to be taken into custody for a Section 12. When officers attempted to handcuff the male subject, he resisted, and officers assisted him to the ground using arm bar takedown. After a brief struggle, the male subject was handcuffed and placed on a stretcher.

Reviewed on April 27, 2018 and found to be within Guidelines.

Sergeant Paul Clark Special Officer Kyle Kochanowicz May 26, 2018 Route Six/Cemetery Road

Reviewed on May 28, 2018 and found to be within Guidelines.

### Synopsis:

Officers were checking on a disabled motor vehicle when they discovered a verbal domestic disturbance was taking place. When Sgt Clark advised the male subject to calm down and put his cigarette down he refused to and became louder swinging his lit cigarette at the officer's face. Sgt Clark then knocked the cigarette out of the male subject's hand and the male subject dropped to the ground stating that the officer assaulted him and that he was injured. Sgt Clark requested rescue to evaluate the male subject and it was determined that no injury occurred. After the officers determined no physical assault took place, the involved parties went on their way.

Officer Mark Braun June 22, 2018 Cassick Valley Road

### Synopsis:

Officer Braun was on a motor vehicle stop when the operator of the vehicle pulled away from the stop at a high rate of speed. Officer Braun then followed the vehicle that took a left turn onto Cassick Valley Road and pulled into a driveway. The operator jumped out of the driver's seat and headed toward Officer Braun with a dark object in his hand. Officer Braun exited his cruiser, removed taser from its holster and guided the lasers on the torso of the male subject. The officer directed the male subject to lay on the ground and handcuffed without further incident. After further investigation, it was determined the male subject was suffering from a medical issue and the fire department responded for an evaluation.

Reviewed on June 25, 2018 and found to be within Guidelines.

Officer George Spirito Officer Jeremiah Valli August 5, 2018 Arrowhead Road

### Synopsis:

Officers responded to a reported physical assault domestic disturbance and discovered that the female party was able to get out of the residence. After interviewing the female victim, it was determined that the male party may still be in the residence and was highly intoxicated. Officers on scene requested additional help at the scene to safely search the residence for the male subject. Officers made several attempts to announce themselves without any response from the male suspect. After additional officers arrived on location, officers entered the residence with a State Police K-9 who discovered the male subject lying in a bed in a small rear bedroom. As officers attempted to take the subject into custody, he began swinging at the officers striking Officer Valli and attempting to bite him. The male suspect then put his hand under the pillow resisting arrest and officers were not sure if he was attempting to retrieve a weapon. As officers delivered defensive strikes to gain control of the suspect they were able to gain control of arms and place him in handcuffs. The male subject began spitting blood at officers and was injured from the struggle. The male subject was transported to the hospital for treatment.

Reviewed on August 16, 2018 and found to be within Guidelines.

Sergeant Michael Turner Officer George Spirito September 7, 2018 Indian Neck Beach

#### Synopsis:

Officers were responding to Indian Neck Beach for a report of a suspicious who was sitting near his vehicle with a long gun. Officer arrived on location and observed the male subject sitting in the vehicle and approached with patrol rifles ordering him to safely exit the vehicle with his hands out. The male subject complied with the officer's orders and exited without further incident. Officers discovered the long gun and determined it was a pellet rifle. The male subject stated that he was using it to do target shooting.

Reviewed on September 10, 2018 and found to be within Guidelines.

Sergeant William Brazile Officer Nick Daley Officer Jeremiah Valli December 16, 2018 State Highway Reviewed on **December 18, 2018** Synopsis: and found to be within Guidelines. Officer's were conducting a house check on a residence that was determined had been broken into earlier in the day. When officers returned they discovered a male party standing in the middle of the living room wearing all black. Officers recognized the male party as s subject with a long criminal history and officer safety issues. Officers ordered the male subject at gun point to get on the ground and show his hands. Once the male suspect complied officers transitioned to a less lethal taser until handcuffs were safely placed on him.
